NOTIFICATION

The University shall conduct the Doctoral Entrance Test (DET) for admission to the Ph.D. programme for the academic session 2024-25 in accordance with the revised Ordinance No. 11 and the University Grants Commission (UGC) Ph.D. Regulations-2022. A candidate seeking admission to the Doctor of Philosophy programme must, at the time of application, hold a Master's degree or an equivalent qualification in the relevant or allied subject with a minimum of 55% marks (50% for candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/EWS/Differently-Abled, and other categories as per the prevailing UGC regulations).

Eligible candidates intending to seek admission to this programme are required to submit their applications through the online process, which shall remain open from March 17, 2025, to April 07, 2025. The application shall be accompanied by an online payment of Rs. 2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand Only) plus applicable online charges, to be made through the official website of Rani Durgavati University, Jabalpur (http://www.rdunijbpin.org). A hard copy of the duly filled online application form, along with attested supporting documents, must be submitted or sent to the Head of the respective University Teaching Department of the relevant subject for scrutiny.

Accordingly, from the academic session 2024-25, Rani Durgavati University, Jabalpur, will adopt the National Eligibility Test (NET) scores for admission to Ph.D. programmes and also conduct a university-level entrance test as per the revised Ordinance No. 11, in accordance with the UGC Ph.D. Regulation-2022.

As per UGC Notification No.F.4-1(UGC-NET Review Committe)/2024 (NET)/ 140648 March 27,2024/7 and No.F.4-1(UGC-NET Review Committe)/2024 (NET)/140648 28th March,2024/8 Candidates who have qualified in all three categories of UGC-NET from June 2024 / UGC-

CSIR NET/GATE/CEED and Similar National level tests, based on interview are exempted to appear in DET 2024-25. However, such candidates must mandatorily submit an application through the online process. Additionally, such candidates shall be required to appear for an interview.

Guidelines for admissions to Ph.D. for the academic session 2024-25:-

The Entrance Test shall consist of a single multiple-choice objective-type paper comprising 100 questions, each carrying one mark. The paper shall include 50 questions on Research Methodology and 50 questions on the relevant postgraduate subject. The duration of the examination shall be two hours. To qualify for the entrance test, candidates must secure a minimum of 50% marks (45% for SC/ST/OBC/Physically Handicapped). Candidates who qualify in the Entrance Test shall be required to appear for an interview.

2. Based on the scores obtained in NET, the candidates will be eligible in three categories.

2. As per UGC Notification dated 27.03.2024 and 28.03.2024, The JRF- qualified students are admitted into the Ph.D. Programme based on an interview as per the University

- Grant Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedures for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations 2022.
- 3. As per UGC Notification dated 27.03.2024 and 28.03.2024 for students who qualify in Categories 2 and 3, 70% weight age will be given for test scores 30% weightage for the interview for admission to Ph.D. program. The Ph.D. admission will be based on the combined merit of NET marks and the marks obtained in the Interview.
- 4. The marks obtained in the NET by the candidates in category 2 and 3 will be valid for a period of one year for admission to Ph.D. Programs.
- 5. The relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to (SC/ST/OBC(non-creamy layer)/EWS/Differently-Abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the UGC from time to time.

However, such candidates will have to necessarily apply through on-line process open from 17th March, 2025 to 07th April 2025 with on-line payment of Rs. 2000/- (Rs.Two Thousand Only) plus online charges for admission to Ph.D. Programme and appear for interview.

NOTE-

Students intending to apply for a PhD in more than one subject must submit a separate application for each chosen subject.
