FEEDBACK SYSTEM:

Three Common questions, based on Criteria-II & SSS of NAAC parameters, were selected for Introspection of working and reflections of Rani Durgavati University perceived in the mind of our students. Google form for Feedback on seven criterions were sent to students via e-mail or What's app group of their departments. One e-mail can be used once for sending the feedback in a quarter.

Identity of students were kept confidential and NO Further Communication in this regard is done either from IQAC RDVV or the Department concerned.

To compare reflections projected by students were plotted in terms of percentage of score awarded vs maximum score possible for such a number of SSS feedback responses.

Every question in SSS Feedback form were assessed in range of numeral values from 1 to 5 reflecting Fair to Excellent labels.

Responses received from students via Google form were feed in already prepared Excel Sheet which produces graphical report in printable form and simultaneously prepare Power Point Presentation within a couple of seconds also.

The SSS feedback System used in Rani Durgavati University was prepared by IQAC Cell of Rani Durgavati University and costs not a single penny for its operation and record keeping.

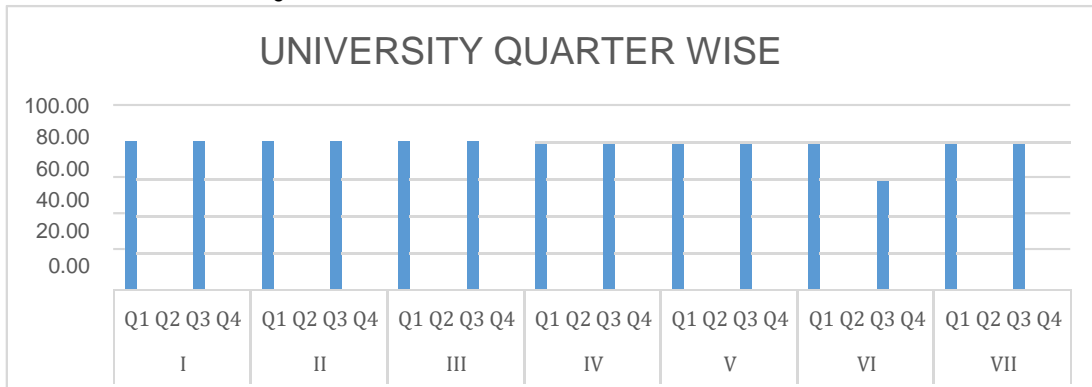

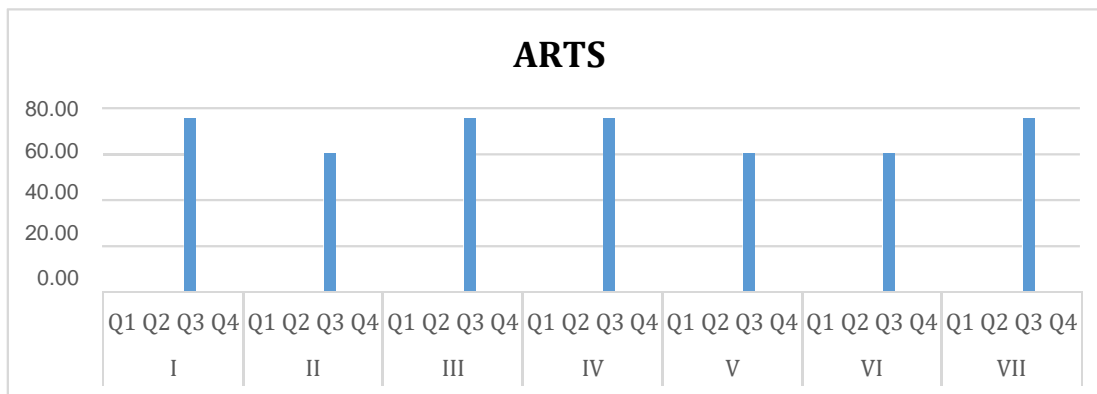

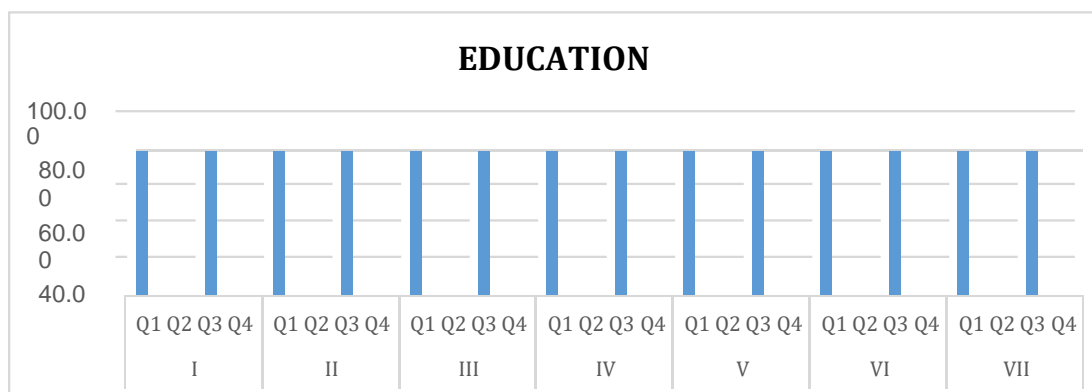

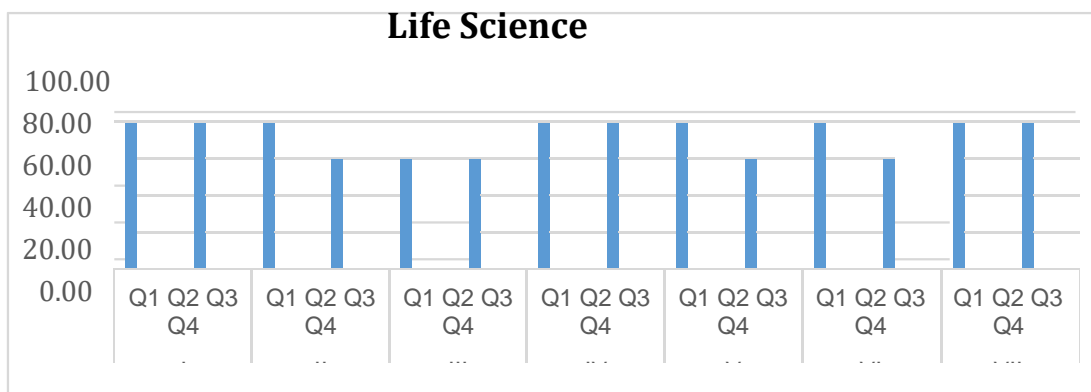

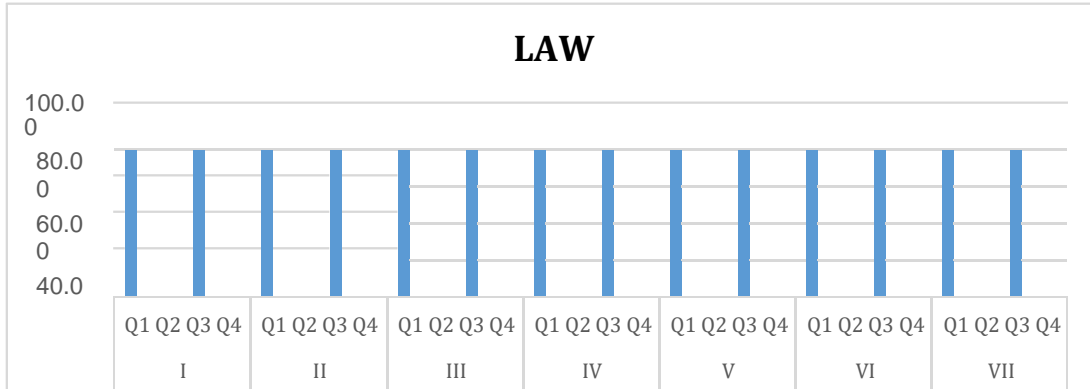

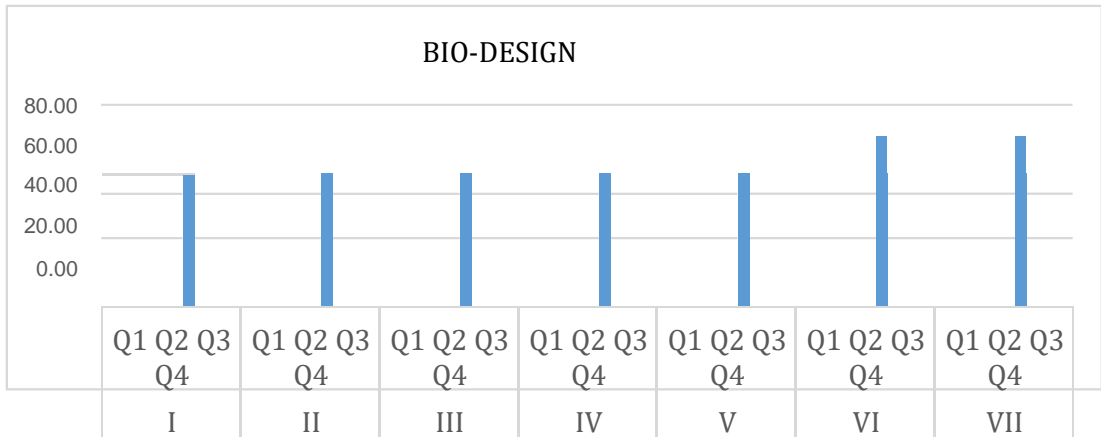

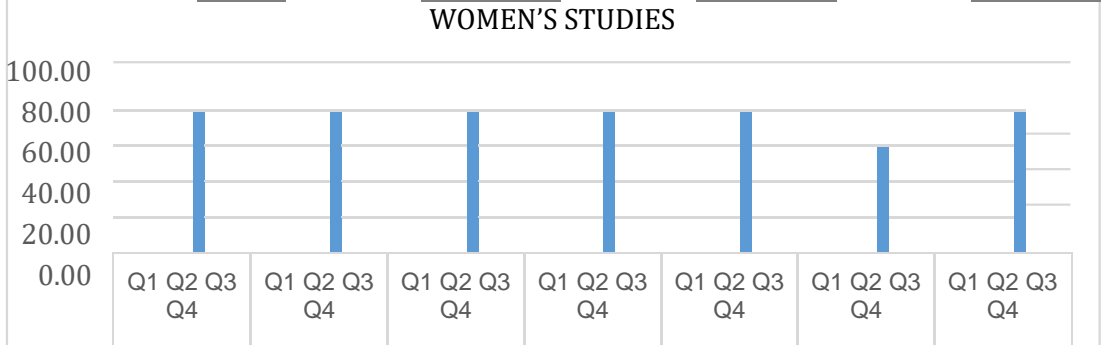
2. Bio-Design innovation Centre

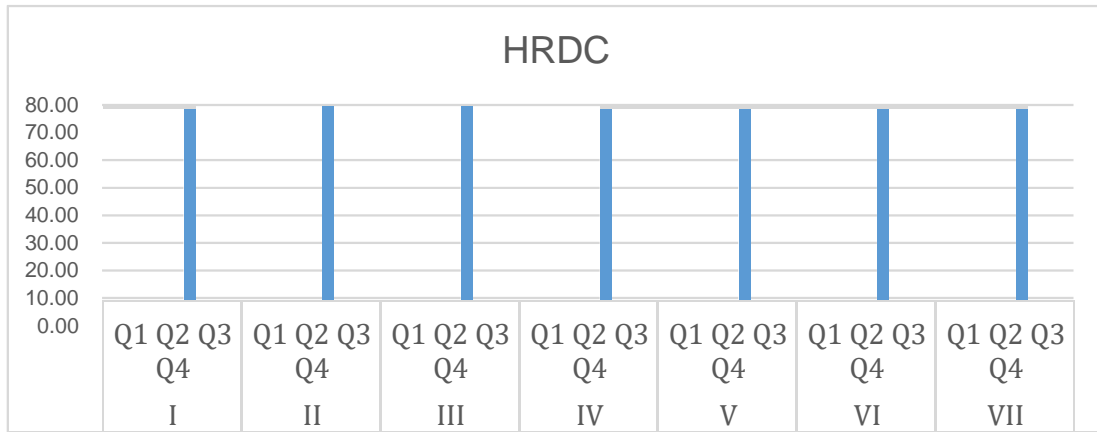

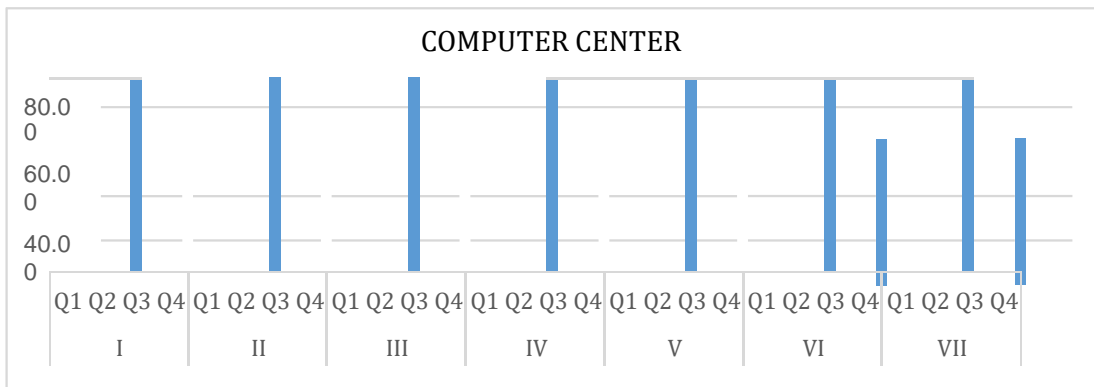
